RE: Proposed Revisions to Senate Bylaw 336 (Round 2)

Dear Jim:

The second round of proposed revisions to Senate Bylaw 336 was forwarded to all standing committees of the Davis Division. Three committees responded: Privilege and Tenure Hearings, Privilege and Tenure Investigative, and Faculty Welfare.

Committees support the changes with a few editorial recommendations. P&T Investigative concurs with previous reviewers that section 336.C.1.c should include the word "must": "If a negotiated resolution is reached after written charges are filed, then the Chancellor or Chancellor's designee **must** consult with the chair of the Committee on Privilege and Tenure prior to finalizing the settlement and **must** inform the Privilege and Tenure Committee if that matter is resolved." Along similar lines, Faculty Welfare suggests that, for clarity, words in the bylaw indicating requirement, including "must" and "will," be changed to "shall," while in advisory situations the word "should" is appropriate.

The Davis Division appreciates the opportunity to comment.
