

**Re: PPM 200-45 Review: Time Reporting System**

The Davis Division of the Academic Senate forwarded the referenced review request to all of the divisional standing committees as well as Faculty Executive Committees within each college/professional school. Comments were received from the Committee on Academic Freedom and Responsibility as well as the Faculty Executive Committees from College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences and Letters and Science.

Based on feedback, UC Davis should not consider spending \$390,000 (for year one) on a new TRS, which is due to become obsolete within a few years (see p. 12, "long-term sustainability of application"). Particularly, as UC is looking forward to implementing a system-wide TRS in the next few years, switching to a new one, in the interim, at great expense, does not seem sensible.
