Submitted for review is the final draft of the Presidential Policy for Clery Act compliance. The Clery Act requires colleges and universities that participate in federal financial aid programs to keep and disclose information about crime on and near their respective campuses. The Clery Act also includes rights that schools must provide to survivors of sexual assaults on campus. Campus Clery Coordinates requested a systemwide policy, via a Presidential Policy, to provide consistency across the system in how to comply with the Clery Act.

During our November 7th L & S FEC meeting we discussed the Proposed Presidential Policy on the Clery Act.

We had some clarification questions. According to the Clery Act, do universities need to report just crimes determined to have occurred or are they also required to report crimes alleged to have occurred? The latter of these statistics would most likely be far higher. This distinction between determined and alleged crimes may become a larger issue as faculty are now being asked to report alleged crimes that students share in confidence.

If the university is only required to report crimes determined to have occurred, do they also need to break it down by the deciding group (e.g., the police/judicial system versus a university committee)? Members also wondered whether if a crime is determined to have occurred by a university committee review is the university committee then required to alert local or state police or does it just stay "within the university" if requested by the survivor of the crime.
