RFC: Proposed Revision of APM 241 Faculty Administrator

The Academic Planning and Development Committee on behalf of Graduate Council reviewed the afore-mentioned RFC on the Proposed Revision of APM 241 Faculty Administrator.

The committee observed that Sections 241-24 (Authority) and 241-80 (Review Procedures) have been modified correctly to indicate that the President will appoint and review multi-campus faculty administrators. However, section 241-20 (Conditions of Employment) only state that the Faculty Administrator serves at the discretion of the Chancellor, and that the Chancellor may terminate the appointment. Shouldn't this section also state, just as Sections 241-24 and 241-80 do, that a Multi-Campus Faculty Administrator serves at the discretion of the President, and may be terminated by the President?

The Graduate Council submits for your consideration the abovementioned recommendation(s) to the Academic Senate's RFC.

RE: Proposed Revision of APM 241 Faculty Administrator (less than 100%)

The Undergraduate Council (UGC) has reviewed the proposed revisions of Academic Personnel Manual (APM) Section 241, Faculty Administrators (Positions less than 100%). The UGC has no real objections to the proposed revisions—to make three administrative documents agree with current practice. However, the UGC is concerned that if the UC President named a director outside of the campus that houses an MRU, the oversight of the operation of the MRU would be more difficult. The UGC thinks this might be less likely with the director's appointment vested in the Chancellor of the host institution. The UGC feels that, with a search committee being part of the selection process, the aforementioned oversight problem would be less likely to arise.

Overall, the UGC supports the proposal and approves it as submitted.
