UCD (APM) 530 - Proposed Revision

April 15, 2015

In 2012, APM – 530, Nonresidents, formerly entitled "Noncitizens," was revised from the 1964 version to reflect significant federal regulatory changes governing nonresident work authorization, permanent residency, visa classification requirements, and the establishment of campus International Students and Scholars Offices to manage University sponsorship of nonresident academic employees. At that time, the revisions reflected changes in federal regulations and terminology, with no substantive policy or practice changes, so the revision to APM – 530 was issued as a technical revision. As a result of revisions to the systemwide policy, we have updated the language of UCD 530 to be consistent with the systemwide document. The description of the fee-for-service model has also been updated to clarify which fees must be paid by the university (and its departments), and which might be paid by the nonresident scholar. Please note: the enclosed document contains a tracked change version and a clean copy.

CPB reviewed and discussed the proposed revisions to UCD-APM 530. Overall, CPB endorses the revisions with the following minor revision:

- Section VI(B)(4) states: The *foreign national* must intend to remain at UC Davis for more than 3 years.

CPB recommends that the term “foreign national” be changed to nonresident to be consistent with the rest of the policy.
