

Undergraduate Council Position on Faculty Role in Advising

Under the principle of shared governance, and consistent with Regents 105 that stipulates that “Academic Senate shall authorize and supervise all courses and curricula offered under the sole or joint jurisdiction of the departments, colleges, schools, graduate divisions, or other University academic agencies approved,” the faculty holds the authority over the curriculum and academic advising of students, which includes advising done by the faculty as well as academic advising performed by staff trained in the curriculum requirements determined by the faculty.
