RE: Nominations for 2020-21 Faculty Distinguished Research Award

The Davis Division of the Academic Senate invites nominations for the 2020-21 Faculty Distinguished Research Award (FDRA). The FDRA recognizes the transformative and cumulative work in the recipient's respective field and is the highest honor the Davis Division awards to its members. A nominee should be an outstanding scholar and researcher, recognized as an international leader in their discipline. The committee focuses on research carried out at UC Davis; accordingly, a nominee must have been a UC Davis faculty member for at least ten years.

The recipient will share their work with the campus community through a public lecture on a topic of the recipient's choice. The lecture will take place in Spring 2021, dependent on Campus Operating Status. The recipient will also receive an honorarium.

Nomination Package Requirements

Nomination packages must be submitted as a single PDF and include:

1. A letter (up to three pages) outlining the nominee's qualifications. The letter should describe the originality, rigor, and impact of the nominee and their work carried out at UC Davis.
2. A current CV, with the most significant items indicated.
3. Up to two examples of the nominee's work that demonstrate its distinctive quality.

All nominations must be peer submitted. Self-nominations **will not** be accepted.

The FDRA Committee may request additional information as needed.

The deadline for nominations is Monday, December 21, 2020. Submit nomination packages as a single PDF file to Davis Division Policy Analyst Elizabeth Ramirez at lizramirez@ucdavis.edu. Any questions can also be sent to Elizabeth.
