**Winter 2023 Instructional Guidance**

Dear Colleagues,

In preparation for the strike lasting into winter 2023, the Committee on Courses of Instruction (COCI) is releasing guidance for winter 2023 instruction. COCI will allow certain types of in-person instructional hours to be offered asynchronously so that instructors can maintain course learning outcomes with reduced instructional support. If you will be making any of the allowed adjustments to your course, it is extremely important that you notify COCI via this [Qualtrics survey](#) by January 4, 2023. COCI needs to track the impact across campus.

If you would like to request an adjustment that is not on the list, please submit your request via the same [Qualtrics survey](#). A COCI representative will respond to you as soon as possible.

COCI will allow these course adjustments to remain in place for up to two weeks after the end of the strike, at which point courses must return to their normal instructional modes.
